

Stanford-Binet Intelligence Scale, Form L-M

Form L-M is the third edition of the *Stanford-Binet Intelligence Scale*. It combined the best 142 items from Forms L and M of the 1937 second edition. Originally published in 1960, Form L-M was renamed in 1972. This renorming study was conducted by Robert L. Thorndike. The Fourth Edition of the Stanford-Binet Intelligence Scales should be used in general clinical practice. It offers current norms and unique subtests in visual-spatial and mathematical reasoning. However, Form L-M, with its lower floor and higher ceiling, is diagnostically appropriate for children at the extremes of mental ability. It can be used to evaluate levels of mental retardation and intellectual giftedness.
